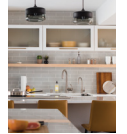

WARM & INVITING MID-CENTURY MODERN

The homeowners have been fans of mid-century modern ever since they purchased their vintage 1960's dining table and chairs. They chose Crystal's Encore frameless cabinets in a combination of high-gloss white paint and horizontal wood-grain laminate in a warm walnut color.

The plan called for a limited number of wall cabinets. An inventory was taken and measurements of dishes, glasses, cooking utensils, etc. were collected to customize each drawer and roll-out. Drawer boxes were modified to accommodate glasses and dishes that were held in place by a peg system. Drawer dividers were specially configured for pots, pans, utensils and trays. Now a dramatic "bridge" of cabinets suspends from the soffit dividing the kitchen and dining areas. These cabinets open on both sides to store seasonal items.

Relocating the appliances completely changed this kitchen. By placing the refrigerator left of the sink, the cooking area has counter and storage space on both sides of the range. Crystal Current cabinets maximize storage by including roll-outs, drawer dividers, spice organization and full extension, soft close drawers. The 42" high breakfast bar is made of locally-sourced recycled elm wood. The remaining counter tops are by Cambria. The painted white cabinets are accented by a soft grey pallet of the backsplash tile, wall paint and LVP wide plank flooring material.

UPDATE & REFRESH ON A BUDGET...IS IT POSSIBLE?

DESIGNERS-KAITLYN STOKES AND JENNIE HJERPE, AKBD

Yes it is! As designers, this was an exciting challenge for both of us to research products and materials that work within a tight budget. Costs remained at a level that most people are comfortable spending to breathe new life into their space.

With an average bathroom being 5 by 8 feet, we started with replacing the tile floor, tile in the tub/shower surround, toilet, 36" wide vanity, Corian countertop, porcelain under mount sink, showerhead, faucet, and vanity light. Labor came to just under \$20,000 and materials were just under \$6,000, for a total of under \$26,000. We were able to create a beautiful space with quality products.

An average L-shaped kitchen has 12 cabinets, plastic laminate countertops, stainless drop-in sink, new faucet, light fixture, and flooring. Labor came to \$24,000, materials were \$16,000 for a total of \$40,000. It was interesting to see that labor costs were similar in both rooms. With today's economy and shortage of trade workers labor costs have increased significantly.
