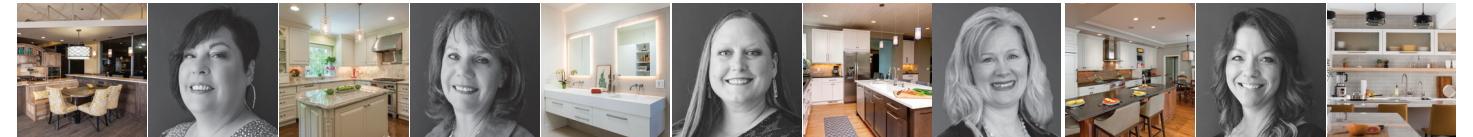

After visiting one of our former Remodeler's Showcase Houses, this homeowner chose Crystal Kitchen + Bath for their project. This kitchen remodel went through a major transformation that involved combining the kitchen and dining room into one cohesive space. A wall came down and a small bay window was removed. Natural light now streams into the room with the addition of two

Marvin French patio doors and a large window over the sink. New oak wood flooring was installed in a medium finish that contrasts nicely with the white cabinets and trim. Subzero and Wolf Professional grade appliances, which includes a 48" wide dual-fuel range makes this a great cooking kitchen. White inset cabinets from Crystal Cabinet Works with traditional molding details and the white, matte

finish quartz countertop from Ceasarstone creates a timeless look to this room. A built-in hutch with glass front doors provides a place to showcase dishware and to set up a beverage or dessert buffet when entertaining. Traditional plumbing fixtures, including a Rohl bridge faucet & sprayer in sparkling polished nickel finish add a sophisticated touch. The dining area is flanked by built-in cabinetry, which creates a cozy space to sit down for a family dinner or to enjoy a cup of tea with a friend. Cabinet accessories keep kitchen utensils, spices and bakeware organized and easy to locate when cooking.

Even though the homeowners personally remodeled every other room in their home, they were not ready to tackle their kitchen on their own. They came to CKB because they didn't want to spend a year remodeling the kitchen and wanted design help and another company to schedule and run the whole project. An eight foot addition was added to the back of the home that included five new windows and a sliding glass door. A new leaded glass window was installed over the sink to mimic the existing windows in the home. The new expansive space made room for a functional layout

featuring custom inset cabinetry in cream, green and quartersawn oak. The pattern in the backsplash tile behind the induction cooktop mimics the pattern in the leaded glass window and accents the porcelain counters and butcher block island beautifully. The homeowner did add their own touch by building custom banquet seating and buffet cabinets in their in-home cabinetry shop, and hand painted the craftsman border on the ceiling. After all their hard work over the last 30 years, they finally have the kitchen they've always dreamed of.
